Please follow these steps to fix:

Start » Control Panel » Device Manager (icon view) » Expand Sound, video and game controllers list » Double-click on Avnex Virtual Audio Device » In General tab, check if device status is "This device is working properly."

If it is not, go to Driver tab » Uninstall

Then, manually install AV Virtual Audio Device: Right-click on a VCSD 7.0 shortcut >> Choose Properties >> In Shortcut tab, select Open File Location >> Choose Driver folder >> Run (Right-click > Run as Administrator) drvinst.exe (32-bit OS) or _inst64.exe (64-bit OS) >> Wait till the MSDOS window automatically close.

Note: Keep your antivirus off during installation progress.
