Hi Smith,

In this case, please clarify that the Duplex button is turned on so that you could hear your changed voice output.

Also, please check if AV Virtual Audio Driver is properly installed.

1. Go to Device Manager » Sound, video and game controllers » Double-click on Avnex Virtual Audio Device » In General tab, check if device status is "This device is working properly."
2. If it is not, right-click on a VCSD 7.0 shortcut >> Choose Properties >> In Shortcut tab, select Open File Location >> Choose Driver folder >> Run drvinst.exe (32-bit OS) or _inst64.exe (64-bit OS) (It is recommended to Right-click » Run as Administrator) >> Wait till the MSDOS window automatically close.

Finally, please be more specific on the change you made on PC's Sound settings.

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
